What is a 'Zine?

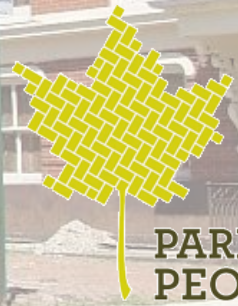
